Behavioral Health, Interventions and Implications De-escalation Techniques (New!)

Developed through a grant from HealthForce Minnesota, this 3-credit course was first offered at Century College in Spring 2016. It is intended for any student interested in careers that involve direct contact with patients/clients who may have mental health issues.

This course provides an overview of common behavioral health issues, communication techniques, and interventions that promote safety for clients, patients, caregivers, and professionals.

Students will practice hands-on activities related to interventions. This course will be valuable to any student entering a career where there will be direct client contact, including:

- · Health sciences
- · Human services
- · Chemical dependency
- Law enforcement
- Other mental health-related disciplines.
