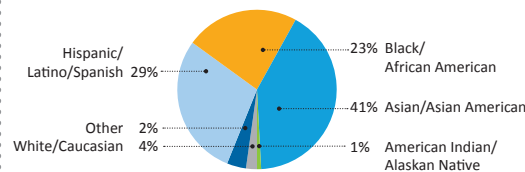

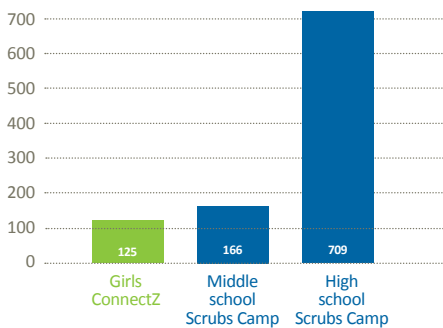

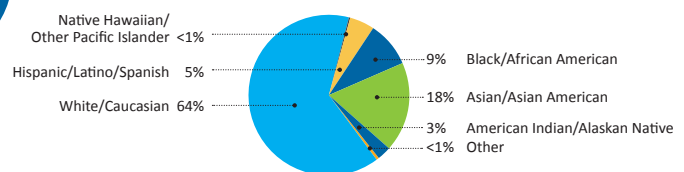

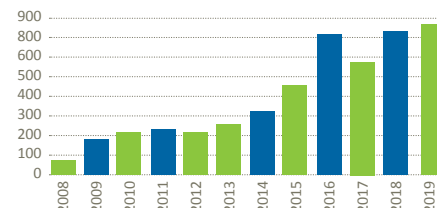

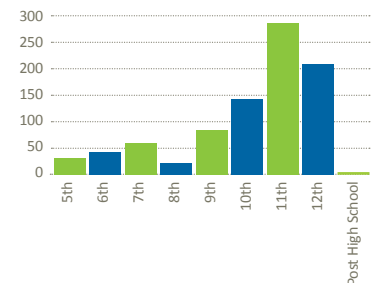
Scrubs Camp Student Demographics 2019
