Started in 2008, Scrubs Camp provides a unique opportunity for middle school and high school students to explore careers in the health sciences. Our diverse population of campers includes many who are first-generation college bound and eligible for free/reduced lunch programs.

At Scrubs Camps students are exposed to a variety of learning experiences, from field trips to clinical settings to hands-on activities — like using the da Vinci surgical robot in training mode in a surgical room.

Pioneered by HealthForce Minnesota and designed in collaboration with Minnesota's public and private colleges and universities, K-12 educational systems, and leading healthcare employers, Scrubs Camps are setting the stage for students to start their educational journey to become the diverse workforce Minnesota will need



# A HANDS-ON CURRICULUM THAT ENGAGES, INSPIRES AND MOTIVATES

At Scrubs Camp, students experience what it's like to work in healthcare through fun and engaging hands-on coursework and simulations led by faculty and working professionals.

Camps vary in length from 2 to 6 days. The majority are day camps, some are residential or overnight. Regardless of the format, the consistent element is immersion in the experience of delivering healthcare at every level — from ambulance bays and medical labs to veterinary clinics and hospital units.








